Possibility to have lunch, snacks, sandwiches, and drinks on site.


Barbecue will be organized on Wednesday, September 27th.

4 Other important information

4.1 Firearms and ammunition

4.1.1 <u>Import/Export</u>

All delegations must complete the **Firearms Form** and return it, along with copies of all **valid Passport**, to the French Federation. After receiving these forms, the French Shooting Federation will send to all delegation individual invitations which will be necessary to enter France with the weapons. This invitation will be the only official form that will have to be presented to French custom and police at the aiport or border.

When travelling by plane, lead projectiles and shot are not allowed on carry-on baggage and / or with the firearm. They have to be transported in a separate appropriate container.

4.1.2 <u>Transportation and Storage</u>

The armoury (firearms storage) is located at the shooting range; a resting place with table and seats will be provided nearby.

The armoury will be opened from the Official Arrival Day until the Official Departure Day.

When entering France, you will need to have an invitation letter and claim possession of the firearms to the officer when crossing the border. Persons with EU firearm permits do not need to show any forms or pay any taxes.
